Guidelines

Eisenhower Park is a premier destination for outdoor fun, offering something for everyone! From Bodie's Place Playground and the Splash Pad to Foote Field and scenic walking trails, there's no shortage of activities to enjoy. There are eight tennis courts and eight pickleball courts all available for reservations.

Reservation Policy

- Milford residents over the age of 18 may reserve a court, but may not book more than 1 court in a day and a maximum of 3 courts in a calendar week.
- Reservation requests are for individual play only. No lessons, team practices, clinics or league matches.
- Courts left vacant 15 minutes after reservation time are available for walk-up play - Open courts are first come first serve.

- All courts are reservable up to 7 days in advance; Reservations open at 10:00AM.

(Fowler Field)

Located in the heart of downtown Milford, right behind the Milford Public Library, Fowler Field is a vibrant community space offering recreation for all ages. With a playground, basketball courts, and dedicated spaces for tennis and pickleball, it's the perfect place to play, compete, and have fun. Our two tennis courts and six pickleball courts are all available for reservations
