BEACH PARKING – FAQs

What does the current Resident Parking Sticker look like?



<u>Where do I need a sticker to park?</u> Parking at Gulf Beach and Walnut Beach requires a Resident Sticker or a daily parking ticket.

<u>When do I need a sticker to park or When does the non-resident fee parking fee apply?</u> From the Saturday prior to Memorial Day to and including Labor Day of each year during beach hours (sunrise to 10:00p) as set forth of Section 16-2.

<u>Where do I get a Resident Parking Sticker?</u> New annually issued Resident Parking Stickers are available from the Milford Tax Collector's Office. The office is located at the Parsons Government Complex, 70 West River Street, Milford, CT and is open Monday through Friday from 8:30a to 4:30p.

<u>Can non-residents buy a "Season Pass"</u>? Yes, Season Passes are available for \$150. A Season Pass can be purchased at the Traffic Division of the Milford Police Department, 430 Boston Post Road. The Traffic Division is Monday through Friday from 8:30a to 4:30p.

How much does it cost for those without a current Resident Parking Sticker or a Non-Resident to park? \$15.00 per day per car.

When did the fee go up? The fee was raised, by Ordinance 14-13, from \$5.00 to \$15.00 in March 2016.

I am a resident but I did not get my sticker yet. Do I have to pay? Yes.

<u>What should I do if I arrive before the parking attendant is on duty?</u> Residents with a current Resident Parking Sticker can park as normal. Those without stickers or Non-Residents should park and then should pay the parking attendant when they arrive for duty.

Do "Handicapped" non-residents have to pay and where can they park? Yes, non-residents displaying a handicapped placard or handicapped registration plates must pay to park. They can park in any designated handicap space or in any regular space close to the beach.

Can I drop off and unload my car without paying to park? Yes

Can I drive through the lot and come back out? Yes

<u>I am here for an event or to play in the volleyball league, do I need a Resident Sticker and/or Do I have to pay to park?</u> Yes, the same parking regulations apply.

If the Police give me a ticket, how much does it cost? A ticket for parking without a current Milford Resident Parking Sticker (violation of Beach Ordinance) issued by the Milford Police costs \$30.00. All questions about tickets can be directed to the Traffic Division of the Milford Police Department, 430 Boston Post Road, Milford, CT. The Traffic Division is Monday through Friday from 8:30a to 4:30p.

<u>Can I park on the street?</u> Yes, parking is allowed on the street in a marked parking spot. Street parking has a 2 hour limit. A ticket for parking "More Than Time Limit" issued by the Milford Police costs \$30.00. All questions about tickets can be directed to the Traffic Division of the Milford Police Department, 430 Boston Post Road, Milford, CT. The Traffic Division is Monday through Friday from 8:30a to 4:30p.
